

Bespoke design

- At your first appointment we will spend plenty of time getting to know you, discussing what you would like us to make, and finding out as much information as possible about your choice of style, fabrics, and colours. We have lots of samples to help with this process and if you have any images of your ideas it's always a good idea to bring them along. We will then take a full set of body measurements with which we will create a bespoke pattern for your garment.
- At your second appointment we will have prepared a toile for you to try on. This is a mock-up of your garment in a calico fabric so we can check the fit and style before cutting out the pattern in the final fabric. From this point onwards we would advise you to bring shoes and suitable underwear to ensure the correct styling. If everything is ok at this stage and you are completely happy then we will begin making your pieces. For wedding dresses and more complicated designs, we may require another toile fitting at this stage to ensure the fit is perfect before moving on.
- When we next see you, we will have put together your garment in your chosen fabrics ready for the fitting. We will check the fit, length, and finishing touches now before finally completing your dress ready for the final fitting and collection.
- All bespoke garments will be pressed or steamed before collection and presented in a breathable garment cover to keep them in perfect condition.
